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This middle aged lady was admitted with a short history fever and feeling unwell. Tests conducted on admission revealed elevated random blood sugar. *Escherichia coli* was isolated from her blood culture. She was later diagnosed with diabetes mellitus and treated for septicaemia. Clinical examination revealed bilateral symmetrical abnormalities of the hands (**Panel**) and feet. It was later revealed that her siblings and one of her parents also had similar abnormalities.

What is the diagnosis?
