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A 78-year-old Malay lady presented with a short history of weight loss and jaundice. Clinical examination of the abdomen was unremarkable. Blood investigation revealed abnormal cholestatic liver profile. Ultrasound scan of the abdomen identified a dilated common bile duct. Computed tomography further illustrated the abnormality (**Panels, A:** Reconstructed Sagittal view and **B:** an axial views).

**What is the diagnosis?**
