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A young man with no past medical history was admitted with five days of intermittent high grade fever, presenting after the development of a widespread blanching rash on his trunk (**Panels**) and limbs. He also reported generalised body aches, headaches and a two-day history of diarrhoea. This all started after a jungle trip. Full blood count revealed thrombocytopenia.

What is the diagnosis?
