

**Shaifuzain AB-RAHMAN**



A 20-year-old lady presented with left ankle discomfort of four months duration. She was previously treated for medial malleolus and a Weber C distal end fibula fractures following a motor vehicle accident 13 months earlier. She was treated with open reduction, screw fixation and plating. A syndesmotic screw was also inserted with usual post-operative pre-caution of non-weight bearing. After eight weeks the syndesmotic screw was removed allowing the patient to fully weight bear. The patient was discharged at nine months post trauma after subsequent uneventful follow-up with good left ankle function. A plain radiograph of the left ankle joint is shown (**Panel**),
